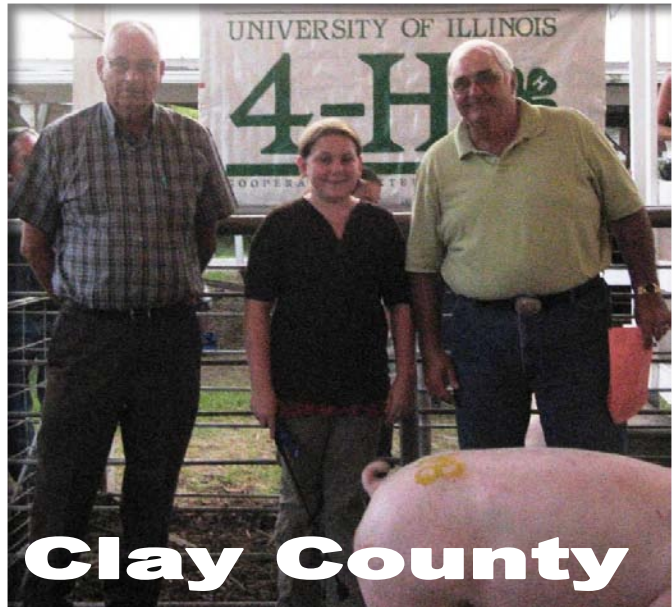

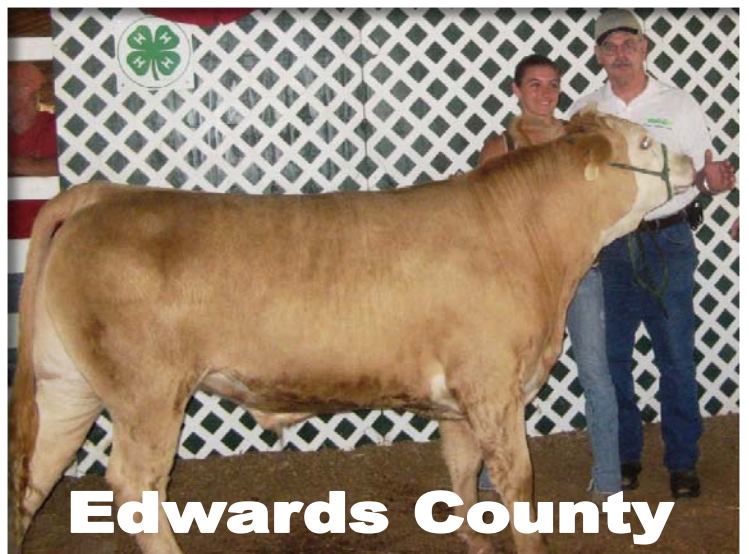

## Labor Day: What it means



"Labor Day differs in every essential way from the other holidays of the year in any country," said Samuel Gompers, founder and longtime president of the American Federation of Labor. "All other holidays are in a more or less degree connected with conflicts and battles of man's prowess over man, of strife and discord for greed and power, of glories achieved by one nation over another. Labor Day...is devoted to no man, living or dead, to no sect, race, or nation."

Labor Day, the first Monday in September, is a creation of the labor movement and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of American workers. It constitutes a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country.

## Traveling? Need to forward your calls from home to another number?

Unlike basic call forwarding where you have to be at the phone number itself to make any changes to the feature. *Call forward remote access* allows you to control your forwarding from anywhere, by allowing you to dial directly into the switch, and change your forwarding number, activate or deactivate the feature. ## Planning to move?

Remember we offer Call Announcement. Call Announcement is a recorded announcement for people dialing your old number giving them your new number. Customers specify the number of months they want the announcement to run. The monthly charge is \$5.00.

## Tired of those anonymous calls on your caller ID?

Anonymous call rejection allows a called party to reject calls from individuals that have activated the call block (\*67) feature. By dialing (\*67) before you dial the number, it prevents the display of the calling party's name and/or number on caller ID phones and video caller ID.
